



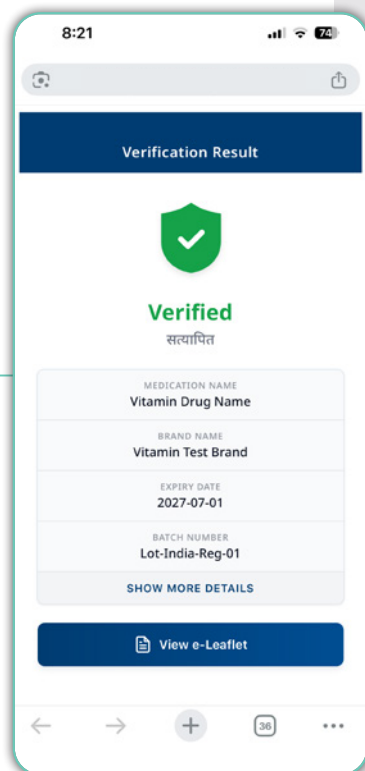

QR CODE VERIFICATION

India's QR code requirements are already in effect and support track-and-trace, authentication, and anti-counterfeit programs.

1) API labels (in force since January 2022)

In January 2022, the Ministry of Health and Family Welfare amended the Drugs Rules, 1945, making QR codes mandatory for active pharmaceutical ingredients (APIs) manufactured in or imported into India. Each level of packaging must carry a QR code that stores data readable by software to support tracking and tracing.

Required API data (11 fields):

- Unique product identification code
- Name of the API
- Brand name (if any)
- Name and address of the manufacturer
- Batch number
- Batch size
- Date of manufacturing
- Date of expiry or retesting
- Serial Shipping Container Code (SSCC)
- Manufacturing licence number or import licence number
- Special storage conditions (if any)

2) Top 300 drug brands (in force since August 1, 2023)

For the notified Top 300 drug formulations/brands, manufacturers (including importers marketing in India) must print or affix a bar code or QR code on the label of the primary pack; if space is limited, it may be placed on secondary packaging. This requirement applies to batches manufactured on or after August 1, 2023.

Required Top 300 data (as specified in the notification/FAQs):

- Unique Product Identification Code
- Proper and generic name of the drug
- Brand name
- Name and address of the manufacturer
- Batch number
- Date of manufacturing
- Date of expiry
- Manufacturing licence number

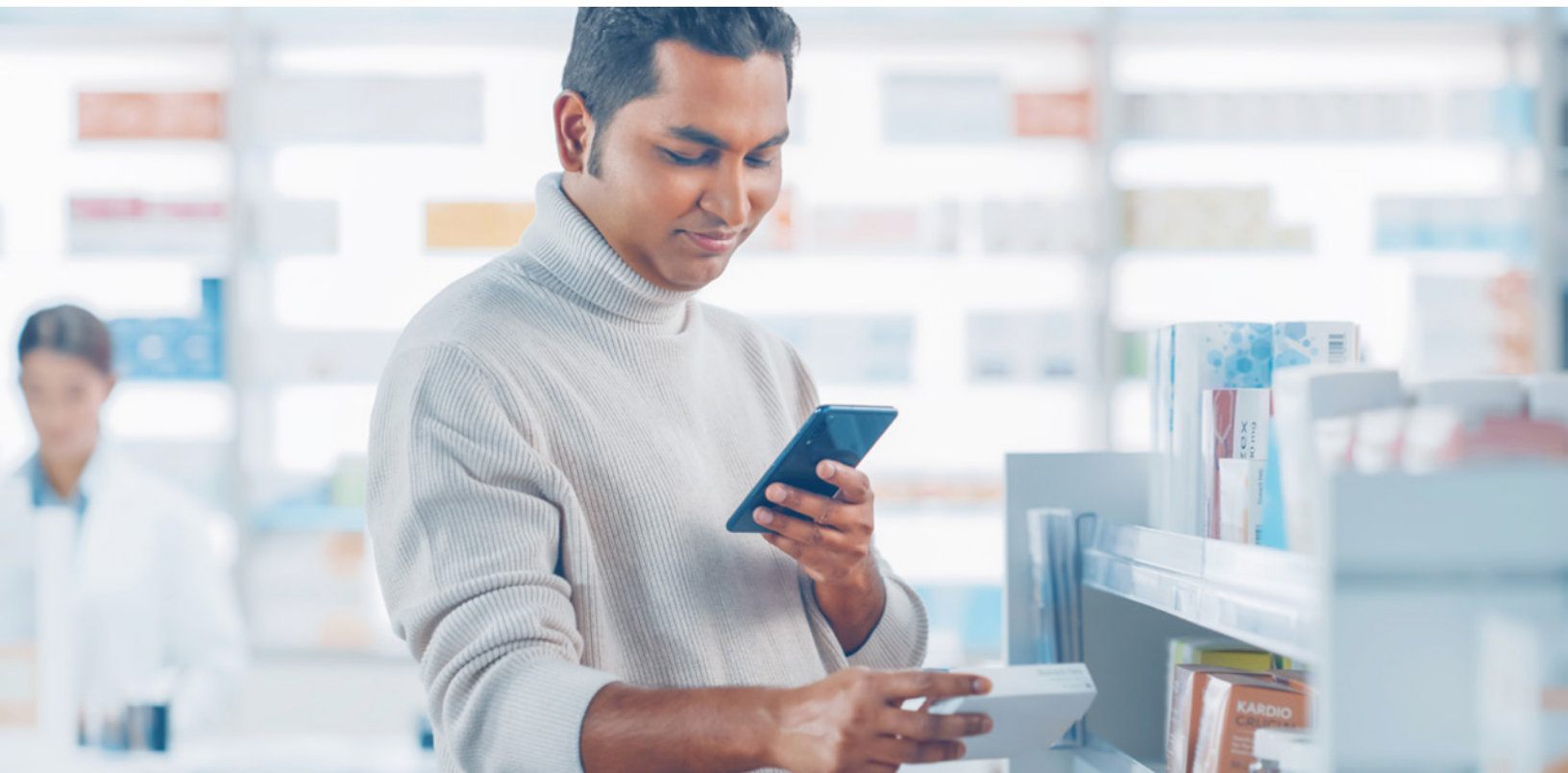

The Ministry of Health and Family Welfare requires barcodes/QR codes for notified Top 300 drug brands to help combat counterfeiting, diversion, and unauthorized sales.

QR codes must be printed on or affixed to the primary packaging; if space is limited, the code may be placed on the secondary packaging.
